

## 2012 Wheelchair Rugby Tryout Protest Procedure

Anyone wishing to protest to have their name added to the list should contact Mandy Goff and James Gumbert as directed below.

Protest Procedure:

- Forward an email to [mandyg@lakeshore.org](mailto:mandyg@lakeshore.org) and [Coachgumbie@sbcglobal.net](mailto:Coachgumbie@sbcglobal.net) stating why you are protesting to have your name added to the list. This letter should come directly from the athlete with information describing skills, experience, past accomplishments, etc.
  - Minimal Guidelines:
    - The highest level of international experience you can have is one World Championship and/or one Paralympic Games (in Rugby)
    - You must be a member in good standing with the USQRA and currently playing on a registered team.
    - You must have played with a registered USQRA team at two full seasons.
    - You must be able to attend all camps and the competition in October.
- Forward an email of support from your coach or a coach you have worked with who can share information about your skills, ability and potential.
- Mail video footage of a full game where you participated for at least 10 minutes to:
