Monitors safe usage and storage of all aquatic equipment and facilities.

Performs aquatic facility maintenance/cleaning as required or directed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Proficiency in swimming, water safety, emergency first aid and lifeguarding as acquired through completion of accredited training leading to certification.

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation; First Aid; Lifeguard Training and Certification required. Water Safety Instructor Certification desirable.
