



Boccia United States BC4 Skills and Scoring to determine Pair Partner

Competency	Specific Tactical and Technical Skills
Time management on court	Sets up in box while talking with pair partner regarding shot selection and order of play. Adjusts chair as needed once decision of who and what type of shot needs to be taken.
Time management on court	Comes out onto court to see i.e. ball spacing and/or vectors to their boxes and their opponents' boxes when appropriate
Time management on court	Demonstrates or warns pair partner to time i.e. (before the 1 minute warning) so there is momentary waiting when timer calls out time, as not to be distracted
Can positively reflect with teammates/coaches after a match to improve future play	Takes responsibility for technical shots not converted.
Can positively reflect with teammates/coaches after a match to improve future play	Is able to spend time with pair partner and coach off court recalling specific shots and scrutinizes the shot selection, and order of play to further their tactical play in the next game.
Can positively reflect with teammates/coaches after a match to improve future play	Both pair partners have equal say in the conversation. They are a reflective listener. Conversations are reflective, honest, and helpful to improve pair play and improve communication on and off the court.
Knowledge and demonstration of Rules	Understands differences in rules between individual and pair play and uses this knowledge of rules to their pair advantage.



Boccia United States BC4 Skills and Scoring to determine Pair Partner

Competency	Specific Tactical and Technical Skills
Shot selection	Takes into consideration their opponents' and their pair partner's make and density of balls remaining.
Shot selection	Takes into consideration their opponents' and their pair partner's abilities to make shots
Shot selection	Takes into consideration both their opponents' and their collective number of balls remaining as to which of the pair should shoot
Shot selection	Has forethought to cover up or put balls in an advantageous position to hold their opponent to one point when needed
Shot selection	Athlete sees in 3D and suggest several viable shots i.e. including moving the jack back to their advantage. There is a clear indication that the athlete "sees the whole constellation" and the likelihood of scoring in multiple ways. It is evident after the match that they collectively made the correct tactical decisions.
Order of play	Takes into consideration their opponents' and their pair partner's make and density of balls remaining.
Order of play	Takes into consideration both their opponents' and their collective number of balls remaining (ball advantage) as to which of the pair should shoot.
Order of play	Takes into consideration their opponents' and their pair partner's abilities to make shots
Communication on and off the court	Athlete uses two-way communication that is positive, respectful, clear, direct, and concise that allows for clear understanding of what the shot will be. Much like a caddy and a golfer. It is as if both are committed to the shot even though only one is shooting. No one athlete is "in charge". Decision-making is mutual.



Boccia United States BC4 Skills and Scoring to determine Pair Partner

Specific Tactical and Technical Skills	
Communication on and off the court	Is able to spend time with pair off court recalling their specific shots and analyzes the shot selection, and order of play to further their tactical play in the next game. Both have equal say in the conversation.
Technical skills in pair play	Manages the rhythm of pair play and can make same % of shots technically as they can in individual play
Technical skills in pair play	Can identify all viable available technical shots

Scoring: 1 point for competency met. 0 points for competency not met. Scoring will take place across all environments that involve pair play selection. We will score two (2) critical times when a certain competency should be present during play, or interview, or pre game or post game analysis.

** The selection committee reserves the right to take all factors into consideration including athlete/pair interviews, pair play and this competency rating in making final determinations.
